

Connect Group Questions – December 17, 2023

(1) How do you relate to the psalmist's struggle with envy and doubt in Psalm 73? Can you share a personal experience where you grappled with similar feelings? How did you handle it?

(2) The psalmist's perspective shifts when he enters the sanctuary of God. In your past, how has God used the public gathering of God's people on the Lord's Day to aid you in finding solace and a God-centered perspective when facing challenges or doubts?

(3) The psalmist learns the importance of contentment and gratitude. How can cultivating a spirit of thanksgiving impact your perspective on life, especially during times when you might be tempted to envy others?

(4) Psalm 73 speaks to the importance of an eternal perspective. How can we keep our focus on eternal values rather than temporary circumstances? Discuss practical habits or mindsets that can help one another cultivate this eternal perspective.

(5) Psalm 73 provides an opportunity to discuss supporting one another in the faith. How does Psalm 73 help us do that? What are some truths about the Lord Jesus that the Psalm points too? What are at least five ways we can point one another to Christ when one of us is in a season of uncertainty?
